John has been very willing to volunteer his time, professional expertise, and his company's professional tax preparation software in preparing the two Internal Revenue Service and two California Franchise Tax Board income tax returns that FWSA is required to file annually.

FWSA was subject to an IRS audit in 2002 for the years 2001 and 2002 with the auditor claiming over \$15,000 in income taxes due per year. John developed the concept for lowering the tax burden and Randy Lew developed the allocation methodology that the-IRS agent approved for FWSA to use. This has saved FWSA well over \$100,000 to date since 2002.
