**TAHOE MEGARESORT OPENS IN TIME FOR SNOWMAGEDDON:** Palisades Tahoe (formerly Squaw Valley) and Alpine Meadows are now one GIANT MegaResort, thanks to the recent opening of the base-to-base gondola between the two resorts. The resorts, owned by Alterra Mountain Company have become the 2<sup>nd</sup> largest single skiing destination in the country. Enjoy the beautiful views of the landscape and Tahoe area while on the 16-minute ride up the mountain. The 2.4-mile lift will take you to the top of over 6,000 acres of a true winter wonderland.

**FAR WEST SKI ASSOCIATION'S 90<sup>TH</sup> ANNUAL CONVENTION:** Far West will be holding their 90<sup>th</sup> annual Convention June 15-18, 2023 in Boise, Idaho. We were last in Boise in 2017. We will be at The *Grove Hotel*, and *Boise Centre*. Intermountain Ski Council, and Bogus Basin Ski Club will be our hosts, along with a little help from Arizona Ski Council. **WORLD PRO SKIER TOUR COMING TO BEAR VALLEY:** For the first time in decades, Bear Valley is hosting an international ski race. The *World Pro Tour* is a dual action, head-to-head competition, bringing in world class, World Cup and Olympic athletes from across the globe. By placing two athletes, side-by-side, spectators will experience the most exciting format in alpine ski racing. Bear Valley is the only World ProTour race venue on the West Coast. The three-day event begins on Friday, 10 February, with qualifying runs, followed by GS on Saturday (11 February) and SL on Sunday (12 February). If you ever wanted to watch the likes of Olympic Champion Ted Ligety ski, this is your chance. Don't miss it!

TOP 9 SKI RESORTS FOR U.S. SENIORS: According to the NSAA, the median age of snowsport participants has been gradually increasing, with over 16% of them now being "seniors". This proves that there is no age limit to having winter fun, and the name "snowbird" has a new meaning! Four of the top 9 resorts are within the Far West Region: Powder Mountain, UT, Purgatory, CO, Pomerelle Mountain Resort, ID, and Pajarito Mountain Ski Area in NM. The other five are: Smugglers Notch, VT, Waterville Valley, NH, Shawnee Mountain, PA, Gunstock, NH and Swain Resort, NY. What's the old saying: "You don't stop skiing because you grow old. You grow old because you stop skiing! GO SENIORS!!!!

MIKAELA SHIFFRIN TIES LINDSAY VONN'S 82 WORLD CUP VICTORIES: On December 20, 2012 Mikaela Shiffrin won her first World Cup Slalom in Are, Sweden at the age of 17. On February 14, 2014, she became the youngest athlete in history to win an Olympic Gold Medal in Slalom. Fast forward 10 years, on January 8, 2023, at age 27, Mikaela won her 82<sup>nd</sup> World Cup race, a GS at Kranjska Gora tying her with Lindsey Vonn for 2<sup>nd</sup> place for the most World Cup wins. She is now within striking distance of the all-time record of 86 held by Ingemar Stenmark.

WORLD CHAMPION SPEED SKIER PASSES: Jeff Hamilton, a world champion speed skier, Olympic Bronze Medalist and 1992 FWSA President's Award recipient, died on January 10, 2023 of pancreatic cancer. Jeff was America's fastest skier from 1992 to 2002, 4-time Speed Skiing World Champion, first person to ski 150 mph, and set an official World Record in 1995. Jeff was a member of the Auburn Ski Club, the US Ski Team and an Ambassador of the SNOW Sports Museum. A celebration of Jeff Hamilton's life is scheduled on

Sunday, January 22 at Olympic Village Inn event center at 4:00pm. The Jeff Hamilton Legacy Fund (jeffhamiltonlegacyfund.com) has been founded to celebrate limitlessness and the potential in everyone.

**FWSA 2023 DIVE TRIP:** The FWSA 2023 dive trip will now be at the *Little Cayman Beach Resort* on *Little Cayman*, a beautiful and tranquil island in the *Cayman Islands*, *October 7 – 14, 2023*. Little Cayman had been named a top dive site in the Caribbean for its iconic Bloody Bay Wall, year-round perfect diving conditions, pristine coral reefs, and spectacular marine life. Little Cayman Beach Resort brings this magnificent experience beneath the sea directly onto the sand. Bloody Bay Wall is the main attraction, but there are other sites that are equally as exciting with numerous tunnel systems and crevices, both on the shallow reefs and out over the wall. Offering some of the most beautiful reef structures to be seen in the underwater world, this is where divers in-the-know go. Many dive operations claim the late Philippe Cousteau declared Bloody Bay Wall to be one of the three best dives in the world.
