WHO & WHAT'S NEW FOR 2016

Mt. Shasta is For Sale: Mt. Shasta Ski Park is available and for sale. The owners and operators of the Ski Park have decided to sell their ski and bike park. Mt. Shasta Ski Park opened in December 1985. With one exception (the non-winter for 2013-2014), the area has operated continuously. Ski and bike operations gross up to \$5.365 million, generates up to 167,000 visits and operate up to 137 days per season. Former Olympian, Bill Johnson, Honored: *Mt Hood Ski Bowl* recently honored Olympian, Bill Johnson, by renaming one of their ski runs "*Bill's Gold*". Bill, who grew up in Idaho and Oregon, was a local hero who trained on Mt. Hood. He was the first U.S. male to win a gold medal in alpine skiing at the 1984 Olympics in Sarajevo. In 2001, at the age of 40, Bill attempted to make a comeback, but crashed and suffered a traumatic brain injury that erased nearly a decade of memories. He had to learn to walk, talk, and eat again. Bill passed away in January of this year. Look for "*Bill's Gold*" when you ski at Mt. Hood Ski Bowl.

Arizona Snowbowl Gets New Lift: The **Arizona Snowbowl** will get its first high-speed 6-pack lift, The Grand Canyon Express, this summer.

Whistler Blackcomb Extend Season: Whistler Blackcomb has decided to extend its ski season by an additional week. The closing date of Blackcomb Mountain to May 30, 2016. Whistler Mountain's last day of skiing will remain 17 April.

Snowbird Expanding: Snowbird was granted unanimous approval by the Utah County Board of Adjustment on two conditional use permits involving resort expansion in American Fork Canyon. The plans call for a new gondola, two new chairlifts, 500 acres of new terrain, and a zip line. Work will not begin, however, for another two years.

<u>Vail Resorts' New Additions for 2017:</u> Vail Resorts will continue investing in its mountain resorts this summer by installing a high-speed quad chairlift at **Vail** and building a new eating spot at **Breckenridge.**

In the Back Bowls of **Vail**, the Sun Up triple chair will become a high-speed lift, making every lift on the backside of Vail a high-speed chair. The new chair gives skiers and riders, coming off the High Noon Express into Sun Up Bowl, a quicker way back to the top of the ridge where it meets the Tea Cup Express out of China Bowl. It will cut riding time to about four minutes and increase capacity.

At **Breckenridge**, a new 500-seat restaurant will go up this summer at the top of the Independence Super Chair that serves Peak 7. This will improve the dining experience at the most visited ski resort in the United States with a modern restaurant located adjacent to the new Peak 6 terrain. In addition to providing a place to eat and rest on Peak 7, the new eatery will be a launching point for skiers and snowboarders heading to Peak 6. It will be done in time for the Far West Ski Week in January 2017.

We will be at the amazing Beqa Lagoon Resort, and/or October 1-October 8 at a second resort (yet to be secured). Register for either week of stay for both weeks. The land & dive package for Beqa Lagoon Resort is \$1916 (dbl occ), and roundtrip air from Los Angeles into Nadi, Fiji is \$1,578 per person. Cyclone Winston resulted in insignificant damage to Beqa Lagoon, with only minor landscape damage, which has already been cleaned up and they are operating at 100% capacity again.
