USSA Has New Leader: *Tiger Shaw*, a two-time Olympian whose business career includes past positions at K2 and Volkl Skis, joined the USSA as chief operating officer (COO) in 2013 and became CEO in March 2014. Tiger moved through the ranks of the USSA development system, making the U.S. Ski Team a few years before the 1984 Olympic Winter Games in Sarajevo. He participated in his second Olympics in Calgary in 1988. During his athletic career, Tiger won nine U.S. Championship titles, and held top-15 world rankings in two disciplines. Since his racing retirement in 1991, Tiger has been involved with the grassroots level of skiing, serving as head junior coach and on the board of Ford Sayre Ski Club in Hanover, NH.

Mikaela Shiffrin Partners With Vail Valley: *Mikaela Shiffrin*, the youngest slalom champion in Olympic Alpine Skiing History, has signed on to help endorse her community and the 2015 World Championships over the coming year. The one-year partnership features a collaboration of funding partners that include the Town of Vail, the Town of Avon and the Vail Valley Foundation/2015 World Championships Organizing Committee. Mikaela told reporters "I was born and raised here. "I'm just so happy to be part of this group, part of the scene, and to be able to give back a little bit. And, I can't wait for Vail/Beaver Creek 2015."

DEADLY AVALANCHE STRIKES SOCHI OLYMPIC VENUE

Just one day after opening to the public following the Olympic and Paralympic Games in Sochi, an avalanche struck Russia's Rosa Khutor ski resort on Sunday, leaving two dead. Resort officials indicate that six skiers were on the resort's blue-square Labirint run when the avalanche struck. The slide propagated from the resort's black-diamond "Crazy Khutor" run above, which was closed. Two unidentified women were buried, and rescuers were unable to locate the victims before they died. The four others reportedly escaped unharmed.

MT. ASHLAND LOSES ENTIRE SKI SEASON

For 50 years, southern Oregon's Mt. Ashland hasn't missed a single ski season...until now. With less than a foot of snow on the ground and a warm weather forecast, officials at the non-profit community ski area last week formally threw in the towel on the 2013-14 ski season in the Rogue Valley. A U.S. Forest Service snow survey released March 3rd confirmed this is the worst year for snow pack in the Siskiyou Mountains since the survey's inception in 1963. "At some point we had to face the fact that the weather was not going to cooperate," explained Kim Clark, the ski area's general manager. Mt. Ashland officials are offering passholders two options: they may return their 2013-14 season pass and receive a tax deductible donation for the 2014 tax year, or may receive a 50% discount on a season pass for next winter.
