FAR WEST SKI ASSOCIATION RECOGNIZES CLIFF BLANN WITH THE SNOWSPORTS BUILDER AWARD



BEND, OREGON: The Far West Ski Association conducted its 82nd Annual Convention and Meeting June 12-15, 2014 at The Riverhouse Hotel & Convention Center in Bend, Oregon, hosted by the Northwest Ski Club Council. The Far West Ski Association, founded in 1930, is a volunteer, non-profit organization representing 160 affiliated ski clubs located throughout eleven regional councils in the states of Alaska, Arizona, California, Colorado, Hawaii, Idaho, Nevada, New Mexico, South Dakota, Oregon, Utah, Washington, and Wyoming. The Association conducts active programs in public affairs, skier safety, ski heritage, athletics, racing, communications, travel, council development, ski industry and community outreach. In addition to the 160 ski club delegates attending the annual meeting, about 100 ski and sports industry representatives participated in the weekend's events.

The 29th Annual Silent Auction on Friday evening raised over \$38,000 to support FWSA programs. The highest bidders purchased ski trips, golf and adventure trips, and sports and recreational equipment. Saturday morning's Travel Expo enabled industry representatives to meet with travel decision makers from the Association's clubs and councils. Saturday afternoon was dedicated to a presentation by Jess McMillan, a Freeskiing World Tour Champion who has won more Freeskiing competitions than any other competitor. Billy Kidd, 1964 Olympic Silver Medalist; also attended and spoke about his friend and 1964 Bronze Medalist Jimmie Heuga. The key presenters in the Public Affairs panel were: John Gifford, President of the Pacific Northwest Ski Areas Association; Dave Ludwig, founder of "Hope on the Slopes"; Matthew Drake, National Ski & Snowboard Association Director for Pacific Northwest; and John Allen, Forest Supervisor, Deschutes National Forest. Bids were presented to the FWSA Travel Committee for selection of the 2016 FWSA Ski Week with the result to be announced later in the summer. The 2015 FWSA Ski Week will be held in Whistler/Blackcomb, Canada from January 31 – February 7, 2015.

Annual recognition awards were presented to members of the ski industry, media, volunteers, racing leagues, councils, and ski clubs. Industry Awards were presented: the FWSA Tommi Tyndall Award for Outstanding Ski Industry Contribution, to Mt. Hood Meadows; the FWSA Bill Mackey Award for Outstanding Ski Industry Employee, to Jason Forrest of Whitefish Mountain Resort; and the FWSA Jimmie Heuga Award for Outstanding Humanitarian, to Lee Perry, Jr., a long time ski instructor who started teaching for Portland Jaycee Ski School on Mt. Hood in 1955. The FWSA Bill Berry Awards were presented to Christopher Van Tilburg, M.D., Author of "*The Adrenaline Junkie's Bucket List: 100 Extreme Outdoor Adventures to Do Before You Die" and to Ben Jacklet for the Shred-Hood* website and emagazine; and the FWSA Warren Miller Modern Media Award to Matchstick Productions & Red Bull Media House for "McConkey". The FWSA Snowsports Builder Award was presented to Cliff Blann, who dedicated his life to the development of Mt. Bachelor Ski Resort.

Gloria Raminha (Bakersville, CA) received the FWSA Hans Georg Award for long-term service to organized skiing. Other volunteers receiving recognition awards included: the FWSA Elizabeth "Schatzi" Wood Award for a decisive contribution to skiing to Debbie Stewart of Sierra Council (Visalia, CA); the FWSA J.
