# WHO & WHAT'S NEW FOR 2019

Happy Birthday to the McCoys: Both Dave and Roma McCoy are celebrating birthdays this month. Dave turns 104 on August 24<sup>th</sup>, and his lovely wife, Roma, celebrated her 99<sup>th</sup> birthday on August 12<sup>th</sup>. The town of Mammoth Lakes is honoring them in grand style. Best wishes to you both!

Squaw Valley Alpine Meadows Base-to-Base Gondola Approved: After years of environmental reviews, permit hearings, and opposition from conservation groups, the base-to-base gondola that will connect Squaw Valley and Alpine Meadows was approved by Placer County officials. The gondola will begin at Squaw Valley, traverse over privately owned property, and end at the Alpine Meadows base area.

<u>Arapahoe Basin Joins Ikon Pass</u>: Starting this winter, Ikon Pass holders will have seven days of access to A-Basin with no blackout dates, and Ikon Base passholders will have five days with select blackout dates. Arapahoe Basin said it would not renew its long-time season pass partnership with Vail Resorts for the 2019-20 season but planned to pursue discussions with other resorts and resort groups. Now the legendary resort is partnered with Alterra Mountain Company.

<u>Vail Resorts Put Investment Focus on Longer Season:</u> Vail Resorts say their spending priority in Colorado ahead of next winter is on ensuring a longer ski season for purchasers of their Epic Pass season ticket. With all the snowmaking going on, you may find yourself skiing a couple more months each year.

<u>Delta Airlines Eliminates Fee for Sporting Equipment Including Bikes:</u> Delta customers traveling with surfboards, bicycles, golf clubs, scuba gear and other large-sized sporting equipment will now be allowed to check them as part of their standard baggage allowance.

<u>Italy wins vote to host 2026 Winter Games</u>. Italy will host the 2026 Olympics in Milan and Cortina d'Ampezzo, taking the Winter Games to the Alpine country for the second time in 20 years. International Olympic Committee members voted for the long-favored Milan-Cortina bid over a bid from Stockholm-Are, Sweden, that also included a bobsled track in Latvia.

Rock the Pistes Returns: 2020 dates have been announced for the 10th edition of *Rock the Pistes* in the huge Portes du Soleil region on the French/Swiss border. Rock the Pistes is one of the largest music festivals in the Alps, with more than 28,000 music fans expected set to descend on the region from 15-21 March 2020. The festival will comprise five live concerts on the ski slopes and more than 30 après-ski concerts across multiple resorts on both the French and Swiss side of the Portes du Soleil

**2020 NORTH AMERICAN SKI WEEK:** We'll be going to *Big Sky, Montana*, for 2020 North American Ski Week. Big Sky is BIG with four mountains giving access to more skiing than anywhere else in the United States. The Big Sky lift ticket, or IKON pass, gives skiers/boarders access to 5,800 skiable acres. Runs up to six miles long and glades and bowls covered in 400+ inches of annual snowfall give every age and level of skier and boarder something different. **2020 MINI SKI WEEK:** *Big White* is the destination for the 2020 Mini Ski Trip. Big White is home to the best snow in British Columbia and the longest season in the Okanagan Valley. Big White is Canada's largest totally ski-in, ski-out village. It has 18 on-mountain restaurants cafes delis, pubs, and night clubs. Stay tuned for further information.

**FWSA DAVOS, SWITZERLAND SKI TRIP:** This trip will include an extension to *Portugal*. Working with Holidaze Ski Tours, the dates for the Davos Basic Ski Week is February 28-March 7, 2020. **Far West 2020 ADVENTURE TRIP:** Far West will be offering an Adventure trip to *Croatia*, September 3-13, 2020. We will be working with *Alpine Adventures* on this particular trip. This will be a land and boat/yacht trip, limited to a minimum of 30, and maximum of 40 participants. Group air is not available until October, 2019. Once that happens, marketing materials will be put out to FWSA clubs and councils.

**FWSA 2021 SOLDEN SKI WEEK:** This trip will have an extension to *Southern Spain*. Three bids have been submitted and bid comparison analysis is currently being worked on.

**FWSA SUMMER 2021 CHILE SKI/ADVENTURE TRIP**: Valle Nevado, Chile ski trip with extension to Atacama Desert currently being researched for details of Atacama Desert conditions. Possible dates would be late July or August 2021.

OTHER FWSA INTERNATIONAL TRIPS UNDER CONSIDERATION: FWSA International Ski Week, 2022 to *Madonna Di Campiglio*, *Italy* was voted on at April 2019 Board meeting. An *Africa Adventure Trip* has been approved for 2022, going to central and east Africa. And, a *Galapagos Adventure Trip* has been approved by the FWSA Board for 2024.

**HISTORIC SKI CLUBS AND COUNCIL, 2019:** Five clubs and San Diego Council were authorized the designation "Historic" at the FWSA convention June 16, 2019. This brings the Historic total to 28 clubs and two councils; the roster remains open for additions in 2020. The Historic *Bay Area Council* presented *Modesto* (1936), *Marin* (1938) and *Nisei* (1958); *Orange* presented *Orange County SC* (1964) and *San Diego* presented *Torrey Pines* (1961) and the *San Diego Council* itself (1963). There are a lot of eligible clubs in BAC and LA Council. All you need to furnish to the History Chairman is: 1) an application, 2) proof of founding date 50 or more years ago and in continuous operation and 3) a high definition digital logo.
