90 YEARS OF FAR WEST: Far West Ski Association turns 90 years old on October 7, 2020. Our editor, and co-editor and been working diligently, preparing a "*Celebration Book*", a compilation of the history of FWSA in its current form. SOME NOT-S0-GOOD NEWS FROM CANADA: For the second time in thirteen months, the cable was cut on the *Sea To Sky Gondola* in Squamish. B.C. In August 2019, someone cut the main cable, causing the gondola cabins to fall to the ground, rendering them totally useless. They re-opened in February of 2020, with 30 new gondola cabins and a security system, only to close again in March, but finally open with Covid-19 restrictions in May 2020. On September 14th, it happened again. The cost to repair it the first time was \$10 million dollars. RCMP is investigating this current destruction to find the culprits who may have done this. Fortunately, it was done in pre-dawn hours, so there were no injuries.

NEWS! FROM ALTERRA MOUNTAIN COMPANY: The effort from all *Alterra Mountain* resorts will start this year with controlling resort visitation levels to avoid overcrowding. There will be priority access for season pass holders. The number of daily lift tickets will be available by *Advance Purchase Only* and will be tightly regulated. To this end, walk-up window sales will be eliminated, and the sale of most undated lift ticket products will be discontinued until further notice.

NEWS! FROM MAMMOTH: With Mother Nature's blessing, *Mammoth Mountain* will open for skiing and riding on **November 14.** There are endless questions regarding what winter at Mammoth will look like, and while we don't have all of the answers yet, we're just as excited as you are at the prospect of getting back on snow. We do know that social distancing and mask usage are vital to staying safe and staying open. As has been the case all summer, masks will be required in lift lines, gondolas, lodges, shuttle buses and anywhere within six feet of others.
