<u>A SKI WEEK IN TAOS SKI VALLEY:</u> An all-time winter skiing or snowboarding getaway is waiting for you in Taos, New Mexico. The set-up behind a Ski Week at Taos is all about convenience. Taos' ski weeks span Sundays thru Fridays. And Taos Ski Valley has aligned with their regional airway, *JSX*, which provides direct flights from major hubs in California and Texas. JSX flight packages are basically "hassle-free" and include complimentary demo rentals from Taos Sports, meaning you benefit by the same gear, with the same instructor, for same epic Ski Week experience; day-in day-out for the whole of the session. Season Pass holders to Taos Ski Valley point to Ski Week as a great program at an outstanding value. There's just under three hours of instruction each morning, followed by an afternoon of free-skiing fun. The 2024 annual National Ski Council Federation meeting will be in Taos, New Mexico, August 21-25.

MONTAGE MOUNTAIN, PENNSYLVANIA: The 2nd steepest slope in the East, Montage Mountain was first opened in 1984 with just 7 trails, and then expanded in 1987 to add its North Face Complex for an expertonly ski/board area. It now has 27 trails and claims to have the second steepest vertical slope in the east with its signature trail, "White Lightning." Located in the Pocono Mountains, right off of Interstate 81, Montage is just outside of Scranton, PA. It is on the Indy Pass, so if you're into using yours, mark this spot as one to include on your tour of more than 180 areas to ski.

FWSA 2024 AFRICA ADVENTURE TRIP: TANZANIA & ZANZIBAR! September 27 – October 7, 2024, are the dates set for the next Far West Adventure Trip. We will fly into Kilimanjaro Airport, then head off to our lodge in Arusha. From there, we will travel to Lake Manyara National Park, to see the famous treeclimbing lions. Ngorongoro Crater, considered to be the 8th Wonder of the World, is the next stop. We will have a 2-night stay in Ngorongoro, where we hope to see a spectacular concentration of wildlife and the "*big five*", and then it's off to Serengeti National Park, where we will see herds of buffalo, elephants, giraffes, gazelles, and many other animals and birds. The golden-maned lions, cheetahs, and leopards will be on the prowl. We will stay 2 nights at the Serengeti Serena Lodge. An optional Hot Air Balloon safari will be available for an early morning flight over the beautiful landscape, followed by a bush breakfast, for a real "Out of Africa" experience. Then, just a flight away, is the island of Zanzibar, where we will be taking a tour to see and experience the highlights of the area. We will have a 1-night stay in the 5-star Hotel Zanzibar Stone Town, followed by 2 nights at the Star Neptune Pwani Beach Resort. FWSA 2024 DIVE TRIP TO THE PHILIPPINES: We are going back to the **PHILIPPINES**! The 2024 FWSA dive trip will be **October 19 – November 2**, **2024** to Marco Vincent Dive Resort in Puerto Galera and Buceo Anilao Beach & Dive Resort in Anilao! *There are a limited number of rooms remaining* and there is currently a single female looking for a roommate. A 3-hour drive away from Manila, Anilao is one of the world's best macro photography destinations. It is literally heaven-on-earth for muck diving, blackwater diving, and macro photography. It is considered the Capital of Nudibranchs...colorful mollusks without shells. The Puerto Galera diving area stretches from White Beach right around to Coral Cove. It is part of the Verde Island Passage and named by some scientists as the center of the world's marine biodiversity. There are more than fifty dive sites that are an interesting mix of sloping reefs, coral gardens deep pinnacles, shipwrecks, channel dives, muck diving, drift dives and sea grass beds. The divers who joined us on the 2019 Philippines dive trip not only called it *"the best dive trip ever"*, but many said, *"my best trip ever"*.
